- Proof of English language skill (*If you are submitting TOEFL, Cambridge or IELTS examination results, please have the scores sent directly to HTW Chur.*)
- Copy of any employment letters
- Certificate of accounting preparatory course
- Copy of personal liability insurance policy

Terms and Conditions

Acceptance to the Study Program

The admission conditions are applied as per Art. 25 of the Higher Education Act (HEdA) as well as Art. 58 of the Ordinance on the Higher Education Act (Swiss Federal legislation). To be admitted into this full time study program, students must have a diploma of secondary education fulfilling university admission requirements in the country where secondary education was completed, for example a Swiss Matura, German Abitur, UK A-Levels (3), US High School Diploma, or equivalent. Additionally, one must provide proof of twelve months documented work experience in a commercial or tourism business and a good knowledge of English, both spoken and written. If the applicant is not a native English speaker, his or her English language ability must be documented by having successfully completed an internationally recognised English certificate of at least level C1.

Please note: Each application is evaluated on its own merit. In exceptional cases, a given entry requirement as specified above may be waived.

Application Fee

- *CHF 300.00 for students with a Swiss or Liechtenstein passport or residing at least 2 years in Switzerland or Liechtenstein prior to program begin
- *CHF 300.00 for students from EU/EFTA countries
- CHF 3'000.00 for students from non-EU/EFTA countries (CHF 2'700.00 partially refundable security deposit, *CHF 300.00 application fee)

* The application fee is charged upon confirmation of study place and is non-refundable. Upon commencement of studies, the application fee will be deducted from the first semester tuition fee.

Tuition fees per semester

- CHF 960.00 for students with a Swiss or Liechtenstein passport or residing at least 2 years in Switzerland or Liechtenstein prior to program begin
- CHF 1'550.00 for students from EU/EFTA countries
- CHF 1'550.00 for students from non-EU/EFTA countries

Visa and Residence Permit issues

Conditions for Non-EU/EFTA students

- Student requires an entry visa as well as a residence permit for Switzerland. The International Office initiates this process once having received the application fee and the tuition fee for the first semester. The costs for the entry visa and the residence permit are paid for by the student.
- Student must be between 18 and 30 years old when entering Switzerland.
- Student must provide a language diploma (IELTS/TOEFL, etc.) for visa application.
- Student must provide evidence of sufficient funds for living expenses in Switzerland (approximately CHF 2'000.00 per month) for visa application.
- Student must have a sufficient health & accident insurance policy for Switzerland.
- Student is not permitted to work in Switzerland.

Conditions for EU/EFTA students

- Student requires a residence permit for Switzerland. The International Office applies for such permits on arrival in Switzerland. The costs are paid for by the student.
- Student must be at least 18 years old when commencing studies in Switzerland
- Student must have a sufficient health & accident insurance policy for Switzerland.
- Student is currently permitted to work up to 15 hrs per week. A work permission letter must be applied for in addition by the employer and HTW Chur must agree that the employment workload is feasible with regards to the study program workload.

Laptop

Purchase of a private, high-performance, WLAN-compatible laptop by each student is a prerequisite for all study courses.

Copyrights

With their enrolment, students relinquish any rights to copyright protected work, which they may create within the framework of their studies, to the University of Applied Sciences, HTW Chur.

The HTW Chur has the right to administrate and make use of all copyright protected student work and, within the framework of a cooperation, to grant rights to third parties. If no use is made of this right, the student can demand reassignment of his rights after completion of his study course.

When using the work and granting rights to third parties, the interests of the student involved must be given suitable consideration. If a profit is achieved the HTW Chur is committed to agree on an appropriate compensation with the student.
